

Appendix D: Vehicle Accommodation Area Surfaces

D-1: Paved Surfaces

Vehicle accommodation areas paved with asphalt shall be constructed in the same manner as street surfaces (Appendix C, Sections C-6 through C-9). If concrete is used as the paving material, vehicle accommodation areas shall be similarly constructed except that six inches of concrete shall be used instead of two inches of asphalt. The Franklin County Highway Administrator may allow other paving materials to be used so long as the equivalent level of stability is achieved.

D-2: Unpaved Surfaces

Vehicle accommodation areas without paving shall be constructed in the same manner as paved areas except that crushed stone may be used in lieu of asphalt, concrete, or other paving material. The maximum size stone that may be used is 2 inch diameter (commonly referred to as 2-inch minus) material.
