II. Commission Workshop

A. Discussion about Blanket Purchase Orders with Various County Departments

Discussion was held over the process of blanket purchase orders. Certain departments expressed their dissatisfaction with how the current purchase order system is negatively affecting their department. Mark Piontek, County Counselor, expressed concern with blanked purchase orders and the potential for vagueness of purchase requests. Piontek further stated the County Purchasing Policy does not allow for blanket purchase orders.
