QUESTION:

Shall the Gasconade County R-II School District of Owensville, Missouri board of education borrow money in the amount of \$5,500,000 for the purpose of purchasing buses, acquiring, constructing, renovating, and improving school facilities of the District, including additional classrooms at Gerald Elementary School and Owensville Elementary School, a Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) Lab at Owensville High School, roof replacement at Owensville Middle School, safety and security improvements and technology upgrades throughout District facilities and furnishing and equipping the same and issue bonds for the payment thereof resulting in no increase to the debt service levy?

If this proposition is approved, the debt service levy of the school district is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.6700 per one hundred dollars assessed valuation of real and personal property.
